Our main goal:

C.A.R.E provides an opportunity for young with visual impairment (V.I.P.) to unlock their potential as individuals, as artists, and as employees, through ceramic workshops and enhances their psychomotor skills, as one of the foundations for development.

Specific Objectives:

- To enhance the psychomotor skills and self-esteem of young visually impaired people
- To increase their employability in arts and manual work
- To strengthen their positive contribution to the community and the EU art scene by improving educational centers with inclusive ceramics courses
- To engage visually impaired students and promote the development of their psychomotor skills through ceramics workshops

- Professional videos with the highlights from the local workshops and the transnational training events
- A manual with case studies
